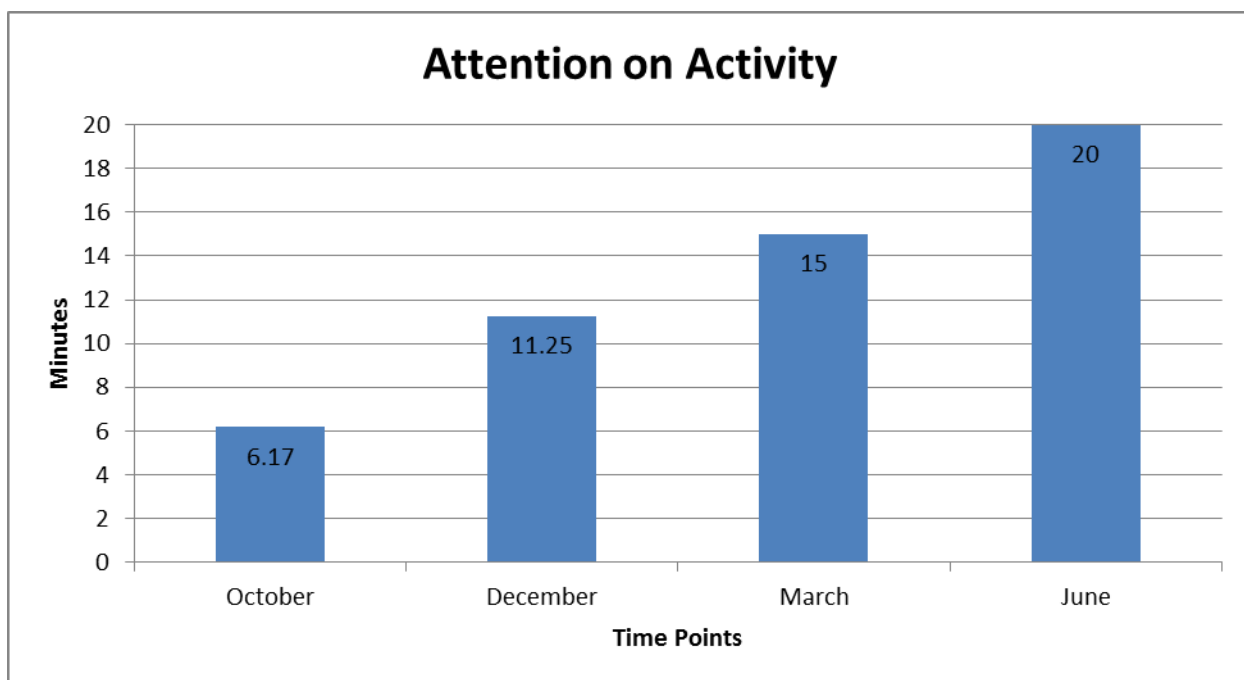
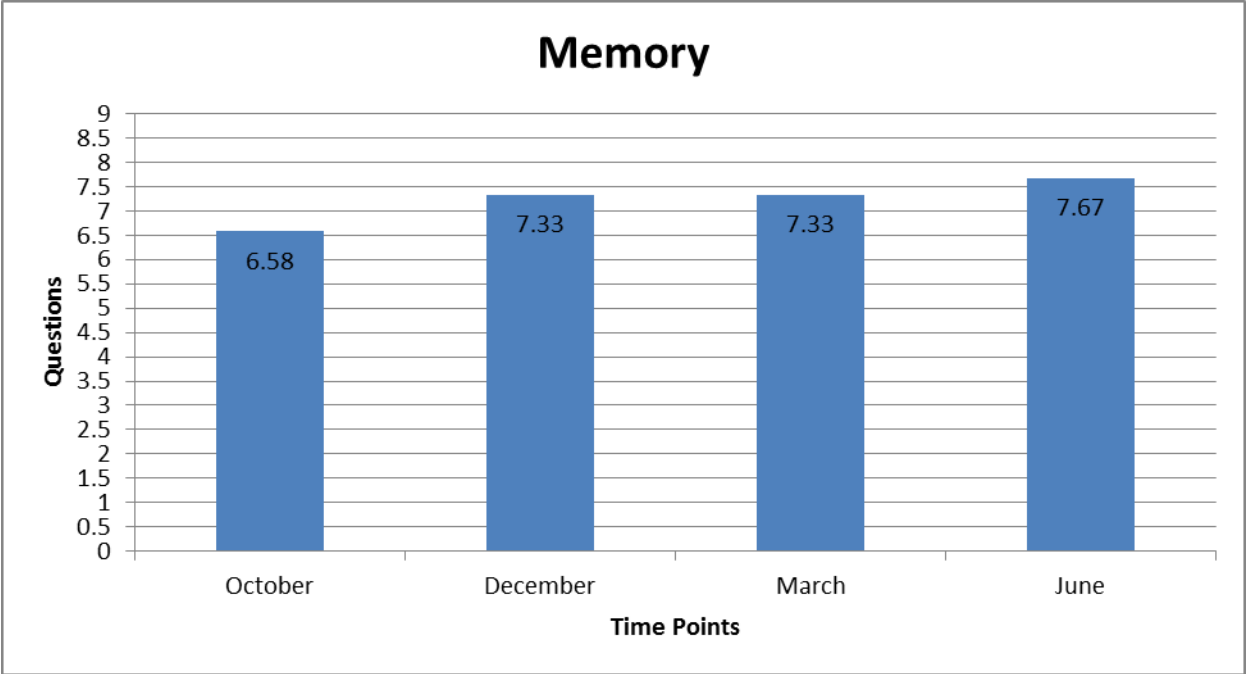
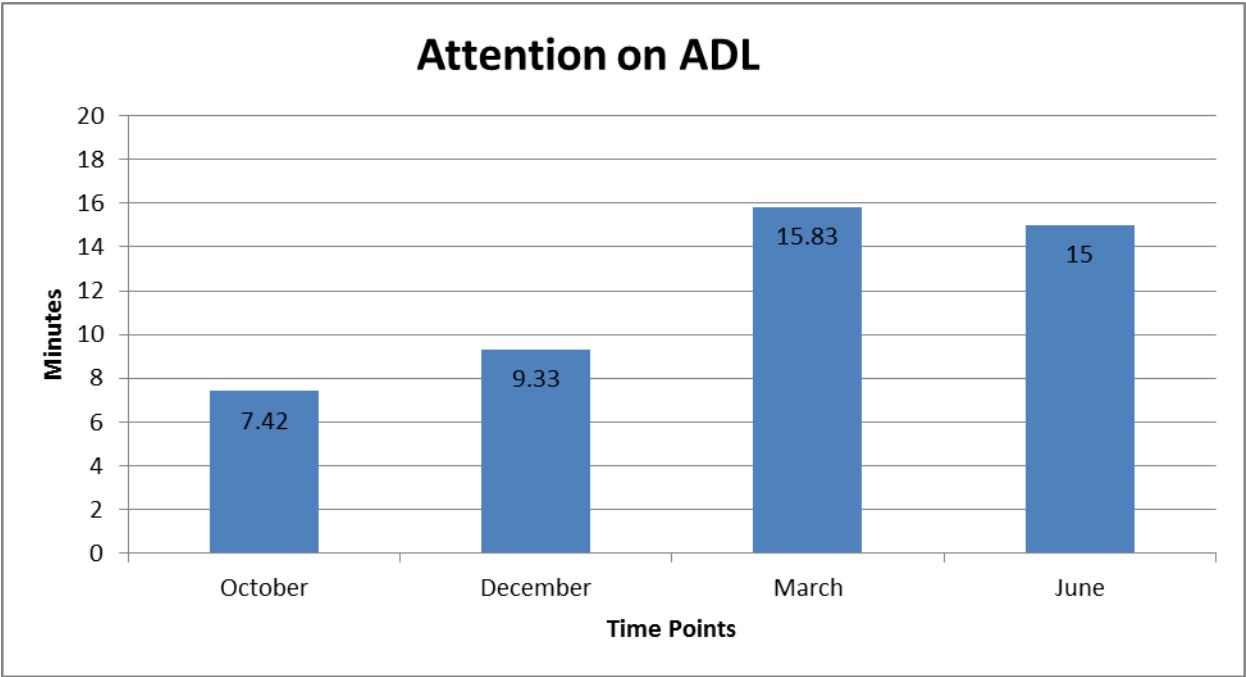


PILOT OUTCOME STUDY- SVAYUS

A non-parametric test (Wilcox) was used for the pilot study due to the data being abnormal (skewness and kurtosis of the sample). The report is as follows:

Over an 8 month period pt.'s score on a measurement of memory improved by 1 question out of 9 ($z=-2.4$, $p=.012$). Orientation improved by .55 but was not significant. Attention on activity improved on average by 13.83 minutes ($z=-3.076$, $p=.002$) Attention on ADL's improved on average 7.58 minutes ($z=-2.812$, $p=.005$).
